## So, what is happening?

From March 8<sup>th</sup>-13<sup>th</sup> our computer catalogue and our software to check books in and out will be down so we can transition to our new integrated library system.

## What does that mean for me, the everyday library patron?

It means you will not have access to our online catalogue, your account, or be able to place any holds. You can still check out books but you will not be able to see items checked out to you online.

## When the catalogue goes down, how will you check in my books so I do not get late fines?

All books due after March 7<sup>th</sup> will be due when our new circulation system comes online, on March 14<sup>th</sup>.

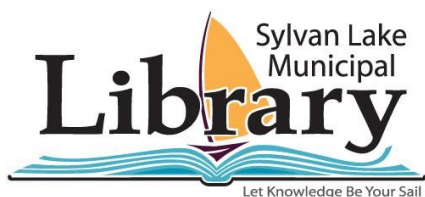
## When will there be cake?

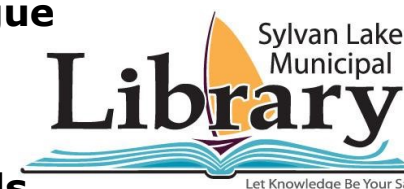
